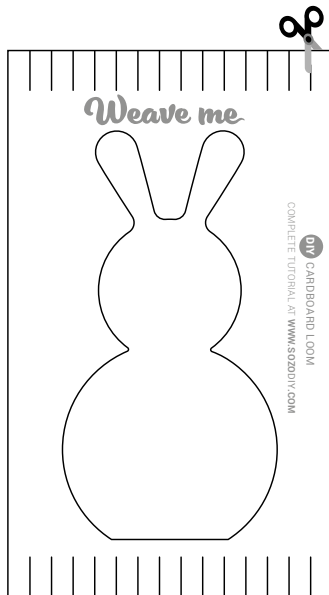
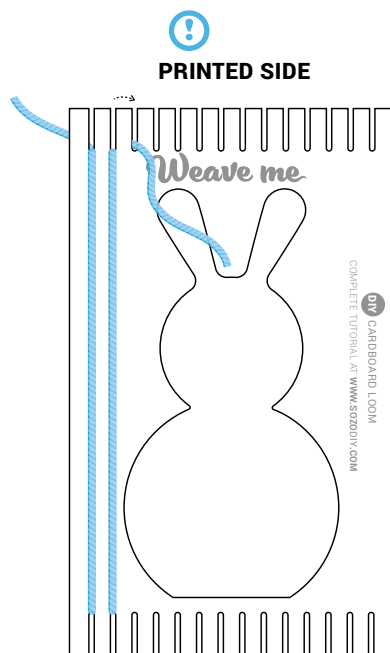


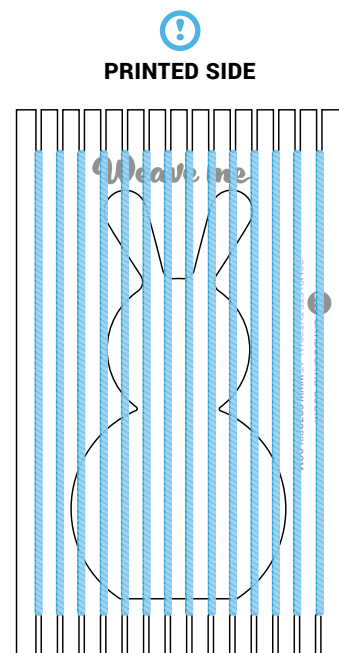
# DIY CARDBOARD LOOM



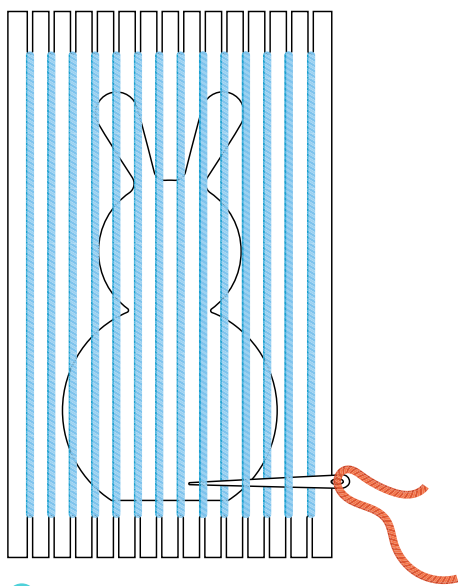
1 cut along lines top and bottom



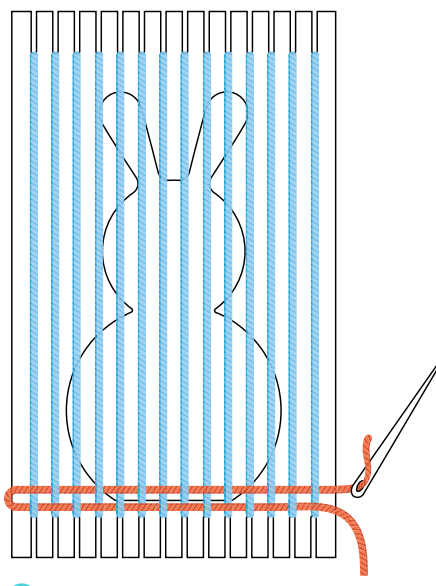
2 Wedge the yarn into the first slit, leaving about a 5 cm tail. Stretch the yarn over the cardboard and wedge it into the first slit on the other side. Wrap the yarn around front of the first slit, and through the second.



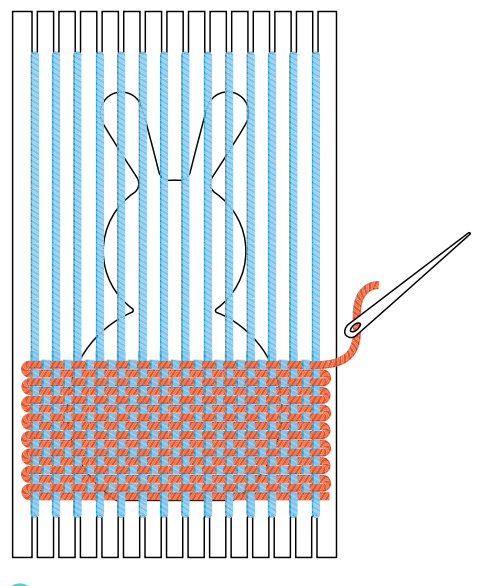
3 Continue until the loom is strung.



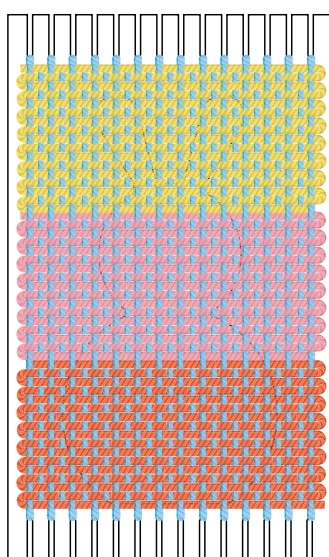
4 Start to weave by filling yarn passing it over and under the warp threads. Leave 5 cm tail of yarn at the beginning of the first row of weaving.



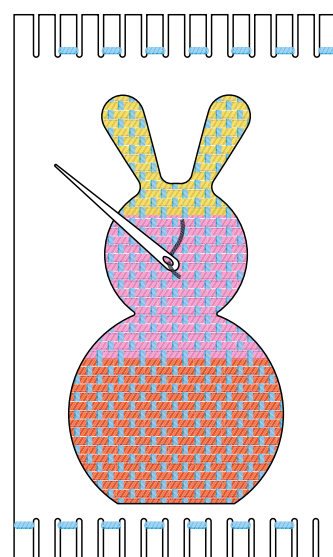
5 The second row of weaving should be opposite to the first one



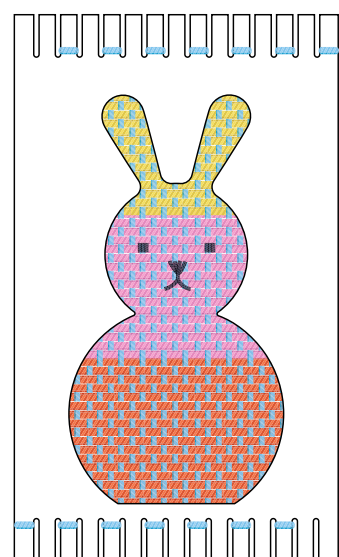
6 Continue weaving keeping the rows tight together. **Make sure the weave is loose so the edges stay nice and straight.**



7 To change colors while weaving, just leave 5 cm tail of each color hanging at the edge (tie together when weave is complete)



8 When done, add facial expression with the dark color yarn.
